School Nurse Health Note

Keeping hands clean is one of the most important steps we can take to avoid getting sick and spreading germs to others. It is best to wash hands with soap and water for 20 seconds. But if soap and water are not available, use an alcohol-based product to clean hands. These hand rubs significantly reduce the number of germs on skin and are fast acting.

When washing hands with soap and water:

- ~Wet hands with clean running water and apply soap.
- ~Rub hands together to make a lather and scrub all surfaces.
- ~Continue rubbing hands for 20 seconds. Imagine singing "Happy Birthday" twice through to your best friend.
- ~Rinse well under the running water and dry hands using a paper towel. If possible use your paper towel to turn off the faucet and open the door.

When should you wash your hands?

- ~Before preparing or eating food
- ~After going to the bathroom
- ~Before and after tending to someone who is sick
- ~After blowing your nose, coughing, or sneezing
- ~After handling an animal or animal waste
- ~After handling garbage
