• **1. Topics Discussed, Tasks Assigned and Decisions Made:**

- Meeting was called to order by John Moran at 6:05 PM

2. Reading of the Minutes: Barb Nelson

- Minutes were read and approved with a motion by Michelle Midgett and seconded by Tara Morgan.

3. DAC UPDATE- Tara Morgan-(NOTES ARE ATTACHED)

- Major Topic- Lee County Schools Growth rate and debt ratio.
- Lee County Schools adds 1800 students per year and will continue this growth for the next 5 years.
- In the next 5 years will need :
 - 7 new elementary schools
 - 1 new High school
 - 2 school rebuilds
- 82,000 students in Lee County not including Charter Schools or special schools
- Lee County borrowed a lot of money and is now in sever debt-but lower in debt compared to other counties.

- Looking at 5 options-Adding $\frac{1}{2}$ cent sales tax- this would potentially make \$59 million for education and they could start paying back the debt.
- People recommended showing parents/community what the increase would do for the schools so they would be more apt to vote for it.
- Looking at other options and different districts are adding a lot of K-8 schools. (1 building instead of 2)

Also discussed Project ECHO- Every Child Has An Outstanding Teacher

- Lee County hires 500-600 teachers a year
- 651 teachers hired this year
- Teacher retention rate is over 70%
- Colleges in this area don't have a high rate of people wanting to go into education
- Lee County is looking at ways to come up with ways to keep teachers
- One idea- Instructional Career Ladder- This would allow teachers to stay in the classroom and still make more money would not have to leave the classroom to become administrators.
- 2nd Idea- New Teacher career changes in Academy- People who came into teaching from another career need instruction on how to manage classroom behaviors.

Standards for Excellence-

Technology is basically the major component for education today- but will these students be able to recognize or comprehend when something is wrong if they are not using technology to compute?
